## PROCULTHER-NET

PROCULTHER-NET - Protecting Cultural Heritage from the Consequences of Disasters-Network, co-funded by the Directorate-General for European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations, aims at laying the foundations for the consolidation of a thematic community focused on the protection of cultural heritage at risk of disaster within the Union Civil Protection Knowledge Network.

Cultural heritage is an invaluable source of identity, evolution and resilience of society. Its safeguard should be a universal concern, as it involves not only the protection of life and dignity of communities at risk of disaster, but also the sustainable development and preservation of humanity. The growing impact of natural and man-made hazards, exacerbated by the effects of climate change and recently by the COVID-19 pandemic, is endangering and making cultural heritage more fragile, increasing the underlying disaster risk drivers. The Union Civil Protection Knowledge Network, established by Decision No 1313/2013/EU, aims at strengthening the Union Civil Protection Mechanism-UCPM by bringing together civil protection and disaster management actors to collaborate and learn from each other.

From 2019 to 2021, PROCULTHER-Protecting Cultural Heritage from the Consequences of Disasters, an initiative co-funded by the Directorate-General for European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations under the UCPM, has advocated for a paradigm shift on the importance of including cultural heritage protection in the disaster risk managment process through the definition of common European technical and operational languages, tools, standard operating procedures at each territorial level. Thanks to the Union Civil Protection Knowledge Network, a dedicated thematic community will be consolidated within the UCPM to allow a growing, sustainable and shared knowledge exchange for the protection of cultural heritage prone to disasters.
