Venue

The Summer School will take place in the premises of the main campus of the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna located in the city centre of Pisa, in Piazza Martiri della Libertà, 33.

The Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna is a public, autonomous, special-statute university, which promotes education and research through undergraduate studies, masters, and PhD programmes in the fields of Social Sciences (Economics and Management, Law, Political Science), and Applied Sciences (Agricultural Research, Engineering, Medical Studies).

Schedule

The activities will start on Monday, 29 May at 14:00 with the welcome session and the keynote lecture and will finish on Wednesday, 31 May at 13:00.

Participants are expected to arrive in Pisa in the morning of 29 May and depart from Pisa in the afternoon of 31 May.

Accommodation



Accommodation

Participants will be offered full board accommodation (breakfast included) in a single room with private bathroom, TV, telephone and internet, in high-quality hotels in Pisa with check-in on the 29 May and check-out on the 31 May.

During the Summer School coffee breaks, lunch and dinner will be offered. Social events will be catered for.

The weather in Pisa in May is warm, the average low temperature is 17°C while average high temperature is 22°C.



Travel

Travel and local transport

Participants are expected to arrive in Pisa in the morning of 29 May and leave during the afternoon on 31 May.

Please note that travel and local transfers will be arranged for all participants invited to the Summer School. ICF, lead partner of Civitas Soteria, will reach out to each participant, once registered, to book flights and/or other forms of transport.

The Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna will organise accommodation in hotels, as well as all local transport, including a pick-up service from Pisa airport/train station to the Hotels on arrival day, and from the Scuola to the Pisa airport/train station on departure day, according to the travel schedule of the participants.

Detailed information on the programme and the logistics (accommodation, travel and local transport) will be provided at the time of registration. Participants should not make travel arrangements by themselves.
