How does the EU Civil Protection Mechanism work?





- Host Nation: receives international intervention teams, modules or other response capacities, in-kind assistance and/or other equipment/material
- Sending Nation: providing its modules/teams and/or other capacities, including in-kind assistance.
- Transit Nation: a country through which territory a sending nation transports its assistance.





Prepare:

- in-country transport
- Accommodation (food, shelter and sanitary)
- medical support
- communication (terms, systems, limitations, frequencies etc.)
- fuel supply
- national transport regulations
- tariffs/taxes, tolls and other fees
- interoperability of technical equipment







- Provide & facilitate:
 - Registration
 - Assistance
 - Coordination

Who? (assistance)

- UCPM framework
- Bilateral support
- Regional/cross border support, NGOs, volunteers
- Agreements (i.e. Private companies)

What support? (from host nation nation)

Assistance

- in-country transport, fuel,food, shelter and sanitary, medical support)
- interoperability of technical equipment, communication (terms, systems, limitations, frequencies etc.)
- national transport regulations, tariffs/taxes, tolls and other fees

Coordination





What level?

- National: ministries, disaster management hq, logistics distribution etc.
- Local / operational: municipalities, emergency site coordinators, unit leaders etc.
- How?
 - Guidelines, standards, Command and Control structures (national, EU, regional)
 - Preparedness activities (Training and exercising of involved personnel)
