Inter-Agency Standing Committee






OCHA works with partners to assist Governments in mobilizing international assistance when the scale of a disaster exceeds the national capacity for response.






# The Cluster System

The cluster system aims to strengthen humanitarian assistance in emergencies by clarifying the division of labour among aid organizations.



# Humanitarian Programme Cycle

OCHA coordinates efforts to plan humanitarian action, obtain funding and monitor progress in the aftermath of sudden disasters and during protracted crises.



#### **Emergency response**

OCHA rapidly deploys staff to crisisaffected areas when new or escalating emergencies require support. Part of emergency response system for sudden-onset emergencies UNDAC created in 1993,




