
- Multi-country projects aimed to foster collaboration between UCPM countries and EU neighbouring countries (minimum of 3 entities from 3 different countries)

- Annual call next one in January 2025






Critical infrastructure early warning systems and population awareness for multi hazard cascading events










Knowledge for Action in Prevention and Preparedness (KAPP) – 2024 (still provisional)

- Since the first 'pilot' peer review in 2013, 19 countries (incl. one region) have volunteered for a peer review 5 since 2022:
 - Romania risk management governance & prevention
 - Moldova comprehensive peer review
 - \circ Greece wildfire
 - \circ Italy (report ready soon) wildfire
 - Region of Brandenburg (DE) ongoing wildfire


Fourth cycle 2025-2027 about to start on 1 Jan 2025
