
Due to space constraints in the ERCC, on-site participation will only be possible by invitation. If you're interested in attending the event in person, please, <u>let us know by email</u>.

#### EDERA IN ACTION: CONSORTIUM ENGAGEMENTS ACROSS EUROPE

After 22 months, we are now approaching the end of the project, making it a great time to reflect on the multiple events where we had the opportunity to present EDERA. These engagements have taken us from Valencia to Brussels, Vienna, Budapest, and Norrköping.

In October 2023, the project was selected to participate in the <u>2nd Civil Protection and Emergencies National Congress</u>, Spain's annual gathering for emergency management experts and professionals. In December, we presented EDERA at the <u>Early Warning Systems Expert Group Meeting</u>, organized by the <u>Directorate-General for European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations in Brussels</u>.

In 2024, we attended the <u>European Geosciences Union General Assembly</u> in Vienna in April, and participated in the Civil Protection Workshop on Enhancing Flood Safety in Europe, held in Budapest in July under the <u>Hungarian Presidency of the Council of the European Union</u>. Finally, we had the opportunity to discuss on the interest of the EDERA products with the EFAS partners during the 19th edition of the <u>European Flood</u>
<u>Awareness System Annual Meeting</u>, held in Norrköping (Sweden) in October.




In August 2023, the EDERA project launched a 15-months real-time demonstration over Europe and in two pilot sites: one over Spain and Portugal, and another one in Finland.
