Project timeline: March 2024 – February 2026

Participants: university students and early-career professionals from Ukraine and the Baltic Sea Region

Online course: society and security, crisis diagnosis and management, resilience

5 x 2 hour sessions/month (March – June) + prior preparation for 2 hours/session with study material via eLearning platform

Intensive Study Program: 7 days in August 2025 at Fire University

Erasmus+

- Organized by at least 3 higher education institutions coming from at least 3 [EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme](#)
- For 10-20 students
- Teaching & training staff (can be also from an enterprise/organization)
- Physical mobility at the receiving/coordinating institution between 5-30 days (usually a week) with a virtual component (online learning and teamwork on an assignment); total time allocation must be equivalent to at least 3 ECTS (75-90 hours of classes and individual study)

Traineeship at organization
- Individual mobility for:
short term up to 1 month
long term up to 1 year
- Group mobility up to 1 month
- The school must apply for Erasmus
accreditation
