Système d'information interministériel des victimes d'attentats et de catastrophes

Context

- The terrorist events of November 2015 (Paris attacks) and July 2016 (Nice attacks), with their large numbers of victims, demonstrated in particular the difficulty and necessity for the various stakeholders to coordinate and rapidly exchange information on these major crises.
- During the 2015 attacks, the difficulties linked to information sharing, among other things, led to families being subjected to unsuitable situations:
 - ☐ Announcement of a death to the wrong family, following misidentification (the papers found on the victim belonged to another person);
 - ☐ Mass presentation of bodies at forensic institutes in an attempt to identify wanted persons.
- These complexities also apply to other types of major crisis. In the case of the Wintzenheim fire in Alsace on August 9, 2023, which claimed 11 victims, the Cellule Infopublic was unable to inform relatives of victims, as the information had not been passed on in good time by the rescue and investigation services. Such telephone response system did not produce the expected results (particularly in terms of informing and redirecting families).

Issues

- The aim of the SIVAC program is to set up an interministerial information system to count, help identify, support and monitor victims of acts of terrorism, mass accidents and disasters, as well as their families, concerning events that took place in France or abroad, including acts of terrorism with few victims.
- For the French government, the challenge is to better organize the management and security of information concerning victims, and the sharing of this information between the various players involved, in order to provide them with the best possible support.
- For victims, the aim is to obtain better information and simplify procedures.



SIVAC

Issues

- Enable the National Anti-Terrorist Prosecutor's Office (PNAT) and the Anti-Terrorist Sub-Directorate (Judicial Police) to identify and take into account the victims of potential attacks.
- Enable the creation and distribution of a reference list for all acts of terrorism, whatever their scale, thanks in particular to interconnection with SINUS and SI-VIC.
- Ensure that this list of victims is made immediately and securely available to those responsible for providing support and opening up entitlements.

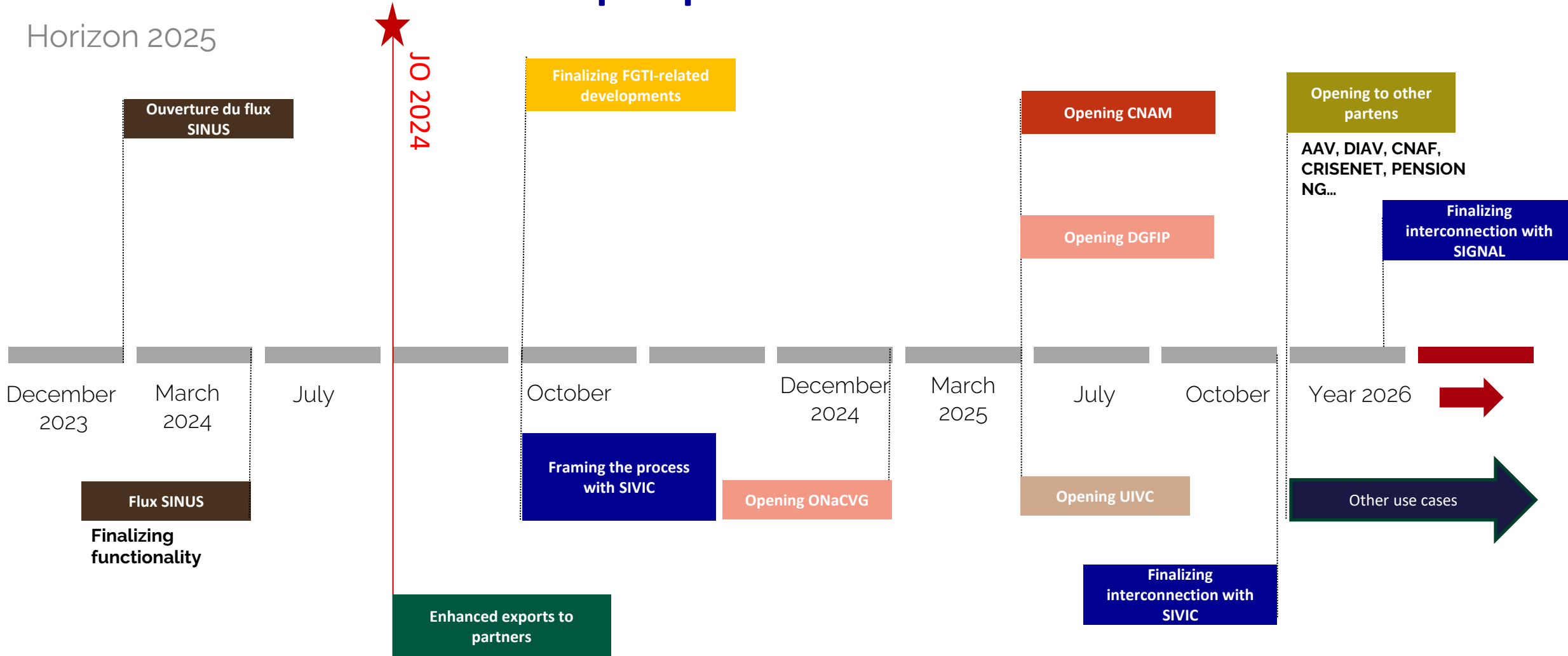
Eligible costs
