UCPM grants for Disaster Resilience

Track 1 - Technical Assistance for Disaster Risk Management



Examples:

- Belgium: PARAGON national crisis platform.
- Spain: disaster loss and damage database; volcanic eruption preparedness; marine pollution.
- Croatia: public warning and crisis communication; project pipeline preparation.
- Latvia: feasibility studies on new early warning system, disaster damage and loss database.
- Lithuania: disability inclusion.


Union Civil Protection Knowledge Network

Single-country grants for strategic disaster risk management actions:

- Strategic framework for disaster risk management
- Investments for disaster risk management
- Investments to improve crisis preparedness capabilities

- Beneficiaries: National
 authorities
- Max grant amount: EUR 750.000 (EU cofinancing: 95%)
- Annual call 2024 edition (12 projects awarded for EUR 5.3 million)
- New call opened on 14 January 2025 (EUR 6 million) until 23 April 2025
- Info Day on 4 February

Union Civil Protection Knowledge Network

Technical Assistance Financing Facility

Scope: strengthen capacities, support investments, improve knowledge base

- Priorities aligned with the Disaster Resilience Goals
- Implemented by the World Bank & GFDRR
- Pilot for 3 years (2024-2026), with projects ending in 2028 max – EUR 12 million



Examples:

- Moldova Strengthening Moldova's Disaster Risk
 Management and Resilience
- Romania Romanian Assistance for Post Disaster Improvement and Development (RAPID)
- Iceland integrated wildfire risk management
- Germany Strengthened economic case for P&P investments
- Info on the 8 projects selected in2024

2025 selection process:

- 13 Expression of interest received.
- Mid-April: results will be communicated



UCPM grants for Disaster Resilience

KAPP - Knowledge for Action in Prevention and Preparedness

- Multi-country grants aimed to foster collaboration between countries
- KAPP projects are expected to be replicable across the UCPM
- Topics:
- Prevention and Preparedness (risk assessment, risk awareness, early warning, institutional and individual preparedness)
- Full-scale exercises

- **Beneficiaries:** Public and private entities (minimum of 3 entities from 3 different countries)
- Max grant amount: EUR 1.000.000 (EU co-financing: 90%)
- Annual call 2024 edition (14 projects awarded for almost EUR 12 million)
- New call EUR 14 million; open for application from 4 February to 29 April 2025 (Prevention and Preparedness) and 15 May (fullscale exercises)
- Info Day 28 January 2025







UCPM Peer Reviews

- Opportunity for countries/ regions to reflect on their state of preparedness to cope with risks; to identify ways to strengthen its system; and to facilitate the exchange of good practice.
- A partnership between the Commission, the team of peers and the relevant authorities of the country/region (supported by CMCC)
- Recent reviews: Romania; Moldova; Greece (wildfire); Italy (wildfire); Region of Brandenburg (DE) wildfire – ongoing, handover July 2025

New cycle 2025-2027 – 6 peer reviews

- Two first reviews selected after call for Eol: Kosovo followed by Czechia
- Interested countries in peer review starting in 2026 may contact DG ECHO bilaterally
- The Peer Review Assessment Framework (PRAF) and the Wildfire PRAF will undergo a significant revision, and will be aligned with the future Preparedness Union Strategy


