CONTEXT

The project aims to develop a unified approach and understanding of DRM processes, procedures, and legislation through the involvement and adjustment of relations with all relevant actors, as well as through the consolidation of the national disaster risk management framework.



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PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Objective:

The project aims to reinforce the national risk disaster framework through a strategic coordination process at the level of the Department for Emergency Situations (DES) and its subordinate structures involved in Disaster Risk Management (DRM).



Expected outcomes:

- Reinforce the National Disaster Risk Management Framework
- Improved Data and Analysis for Policy Development





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PROJECT JUSTIFICATION



- Despite the progress made in the last years, Romania still needs an integrated national coordination system for the implementation of the *National Disaster Risk Reduction Strategy 2024-2035*.
- The complexity of the DRM architecture, involving military, medical, NGO, and civilian entities, demands a strategic coordination approach.



What is needed?

- A systematic approach to integrate all stakeholders and the transition from sectorial to unified disaster risk management (DRM).
- Clear institutional coordination mechanisms for effective response at all system levels.
