Host and organizers of the workshop

The European Commission's Directorate-General for Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations (DG ECHO) was created in 1992 as an expression of the European solidarity with the people in need across the world through humanitarian aid. Logistical information

Please also be advised that:

- We cannot accept late arrivals or early departures.
- Travel reservations will not include travel insurance or medical cover. You are responsible for arranging your own insurance. We recommend that you obtain a policy that is adequate and suitable for this trip.
- We are only able to book and pay for mainline travel and transfers in Barcelona, to and from the venue. We do not cover, and are unable to reimburse, the cost of additional local travel within your own country, including local airport transfer, buses, trains, or taxis.

Accommodation and meals

Participants will be offered full board accommodation (breakfast included) in a single room with a private bathroom, TV, telephone and internet, in high-quality hotels in Barcelona, located within a walking distance from the University. During the Summer School, coffee breaks, lunch and dinner will be offered. Social events will be catered for.

The cost of the accommodation (bed and breakfast), along with lunch, dinner and coffee breaks, is covered by the European Commission through the Civitas Soteria consortium (check-in: 29 September 2025 – check-out: 1 October or 2 October 2025). Kindly note that extra costs such as drinks (other than those provided during the coffee breaks, meals and during the planned social activities) will be covered by the participants.

Arrivals and transfers

Participants are expected to arrive in Barcelona on the morning of 28 September and leave on the evening of 1 October, after the workshop ends.



Please note that travel and local transfers will be organised by ICF, the lead partner of the Civitas Soteria consortium. ICF will get in contact with each participant, upon registration, to proceed with the booking of the international travel.

ICF will also organise accommodation in hotels in Barcelona. Detailed information regarding accommodation and the transfer from the airport will be shared with participants after the registration.

Kindly note that participants should not make travel arrangements by themselves.
