1 BACKGROUND OF THE DOCUMENT

1.1 RELATED WORKPACKAGE AND TASKS

This document presents the project progress meetings that took place during the project implementation period in the framework of WP1: Project coordination and management and is related to T1.3: Project meetings.

1.2 SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES

The scope of this document is to demonstrate the efficiency of the project management on behalf of the project coordinator and project partners, which was established through numerous project progress meetings. Most meetings were scheduled online, whereas a small number of meetings took place with physical presence of the partners, combined with other project events as explained in the following sections.

1.3 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Smooth project coordination and management was achieved by close cooperation, frequent contact and numerous meetings amongst the partners. It should be noted that the project implementation duration covers essentially the post-covid period, when people avoided numerous meetings in physical form. To this end:

- As described in the project grant contract (Part B), most of the project progress meetings were held online, to save time and funds as well as for environmental protection reasons (it is well known that numerous land and air trips have a significant environmental impact).
- The project kickoff meeting was held online by IHU (project coordinator) with the participation of project partners, ECHO officers and stakeholders.
- The scheduled online meeting near the end of the project was replaced by three meetings with physical presence that were conveniently scheduled to be combined with the project workshops in Greece and Türkiye. The first took place in Thessaloniki (22 January 2025), the second in Alexandroupolis (23 January 2025) and the third in Çanakkale (28 February 2025).
- Several online meetings were held during the project implementation period, to achieve smooth project coordination and implementation.
- Numerous additional online meetings involving members of the partners teams that cooperated in specific tasks and contributed to the respective deliverables have also taken place.

2 MAIN PROJECT PROGRESS MEETINGS

2.1 KICKOFF MEETING (03 MAY 2023, ON-LINE)

The project kickoff meeting took place on May 03, 2023. The meeting was held on-line and was organized by IHU.

All partners, project officers as well as project stakeholders were invited to attend. The meeting invitation and the meeting agenda were prepared several days earlier and was send to all interested parties.

Earthquake Resilient Schools (EReS) project capitalizes on the Rapid Earthquake Damage Assessment Consortium-REDACt project (BSB JOP 2014-20 Programme). It is actually going to use REDACt outputs and build on them towards enhancing Community Resilience against Earthquakes.

EReS will contribute to existing research efforts towards increasing reliability and accuracy of damage assessment procedures, by providing the necessary information for "highly significant" buildings as are schools.

EReS partners will develop new generation, low cost, accelerometers and will instrument selected school buildings of different structural typologies within the specified pilot areas, in order to record their structural response due to dynamic excitations (e.g. earthquakes or/and ambient vibrations). In addition, a structural risk assessment methodology will be developed based on state-of-the-art analytical approaches and recordings of the dynamic response of the instrumented school buildings, where applicable. The methodology will be applied to school buildings of different structural typologies and the resulting data will feed the Rapid Earthquake Damage Assessment platform in order to assess both scenario based and near Real-Time damage of school buildings in the Cross Border GR-TR area.

At the same time, focused dissemination to competent Authorities will provide info regarding the use of the platform while dissemination at schools (popularized documents, tutorials, guidelines) will also be provided in order to enhance school community resilience against Earthquakes.

Project partners include the International Hellenic University (Lead partner), the Institute of Engineering Seismology & Earthquake Engineering of the Hellenic Earthquake Planning & Protection Organization, the Gebze Technical University and the Disaster and Emergency Management Presidency (AFAD) of Türkiye.




Figure 4. Screenshots of the first part of the kickoff meeting




Figure 11. Screenshot of the pre-kickoff meeting on April 28, 2023 (online)




Figure 12. Screenshot of the meeting on October 06, 2023 (online)




Figure 13. Screenshot of the meeting on November 25, 2023 (online)




Figure 14. Screenshot of the pre-kickoff meeting on January 12, 2024 (online)




Figure 15. Screenshot of the meeting on January 19, 2024 (online)




Figure 16. Screenshot of the meeting on February 02, 2024 (online)




Figure 21. Screenshot of the 2nd meeting on July 31, 2024 (online)




Figure 23. Screenshot of the meeting on September 24, 2024 (online)




Figure 24. Screenshot of the meeting on October 14, 2024 (online)
