Venue and location


The Summer School will be held across several buildings located at the **Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya** – **Campus Diagonal Nord located at Jordi Girona**, **1-3**, **Barcelona**.

The plenary sessions will take place in building C2, on the "Auditorium José Antonio Torroja", located on the ground floor (room number C2-001). Before the first session on the 29 September, participants will need to collect their name badge and sign their attendance at the reception desk, located just outside the Auditorium.

Dinner on 29 September will be held in the space between buildings C2 and D2.


Lunches on 30 September and 1 October will be served in the space <u>next to Aula Màster</u> (Sala Polivalent) in building A3, located at a <u>2-min walk</u> from the plenary room.

Participants can connect to the campus Wi-Fi network **DRM_SCHOOL_2025**, which is available in all buildings used for the Summer School. The access password is **Participant25!** For convenience, Wi-Fi details are also printed on participant badges.



Travel arrangements and public transport transfers

The workshop will start on Monday 29 September 2025 at 16:00 CEST and will finish on Wednesday 1 October 2025 at 17:15 CEST.

Before travelling, please ensure you have received your travel booking (sent via icfgroups@gdg.travel) and that you make the necessary check-ins before travelling. Please note we do not cover, and are unable to reimburse, the cost of additional local travel within your own country, including local airport transfer, buses, trains, or taxis.

Participants will get a <u>Hola Barcelona Travel card</u> to be able to use public transport during the Summer School. The travel card includes unlimited journeys for the specified days within the city of Barcelona, as well as the journey to and from the airport. The travel card includes for the following transport, within the city of Barcelona:

✓ Metro lines.

✓ Montjuïc funicular.

✓ TMB buses (red buses only).

✓ Ferrocarril (FGC, zone 1 only).

✓ Tram (TRAM).

These transports are managed by TMB (Transports Metropolitans de Barcelona). Beware that there are private companies that operate within Barcelona, which are not included as part of the Hola Barcelona Travel card.

How to retrieve the travel card using the voucher?

Your individual **voucher has been sent via email as a PDF attachment**, and contains a QR Code and a digit code.

The travel card needs to be retrieved at any metro station, including the metro stations Airport T1 and T2. To retrieve the card, locate any ticket vending machines (located inside metro stations), click the button 'voucher' and insert the unique 13 digit voucher code located on the PDF that has been sent along with the logistical communication to retrieve your Hola Barcelona card.

After collecting your travel card, take the orange metro line L9S from the Barcelona Airport (from Terminal 1 or Terminal 2) to the station **Zona Universitària**, which is the closest metro station to the venue and the hotels. This journey takes around 30 minutes.

How go to get from Zona Universitària metro station to Abba Garden (via public transport): To reach Arenas Atiram, take the orange metro line L9S from the Barcelona Airport (from Terminal 1 or Terminal 2) until reaching the stop Zona Universitària. This is a 30-minute journey.

The hotel is a 20-minute walk from Zona Universitària metro station. Alternatively, participants can take the 'JM' bus line from the bus stop 'Av de l'Exèrcit - Trias i Giró' to 'Prof Barraquer- - Hospital Sant Joan De Déu', which is a 7-minute journey (note: this bus journey is not included in the local travel card). This route is detailed on Google Maps here.

Walking distance to the plenary room: 16-minute walk. This route is detailed on Google Maps here.

Transfers from Barcelona airport (via public transport): To reach Arenas Atiram, take the orange metro line L9S from the Barcelona Airport (from Terminal 1 or Terminal 2) until reaching the stop Zona Universitària. This is a 30-minute journey. The hotel is a 22-minute walk from Zona Universitària metro station. Alternatively, participants can take the 'L3' green metro line from 'Zona Universitària' to 'Maria Cristina', which is a 3-minute journey. This route is detailed on Google Maps here.

Walking distance to the plenary room: 22-minute walk. This route is detailed on Google Maps here.
Alternatively, participants can walk 5 minutes from the hotel to 'Maria Cristina' metro station, and take the L3 green metro line to 'Zona Universitària', and walk 12 minutes to reach the UCP – C2 Buidling.

Transfers from Barcelona airport (via public transport): To reach NH Collection Barcelona Constanza, take the orange metro line L9S from the Barcelona Airport (from Terminal 1 or Terminal 2) until reaching the stop Zona Universitària. This is a 30 minute journey. The hotel is a 30 minute walk from Zona Universitària metro station. Alternatively, participants can take the 'L3' green metro line from 'Zona Universitària' to 'Les Corts, which is a 3 minute journey. This route is detailed on Google Maps here.

Walking distance to the plenary room: participants can walk 5 minutes from the hotel to 'L'Illa' tram station, and take the T1, T2 or T3 tram line to 'Zona Universitària', and walk 14 minutes to reach the UPC - C2 Building. **This route is detailed on Google Maps** here.

How to reach la Pedrera via public transport?

La Pedrera can be reached via public transport from the UPC Campus, taking around 35 minutes in total either bus or metro using the Hola Barcelona travel card.

Bus: take the 33 red bus from 'Jordi Girona - John M Keynes' until 'Diagonal - Pau Claris' (22 minutes).





Metro: take the L3 green metro line from 'Zona Universitària' to 'Diagonal'.
