

Since its creation, the INLINE Community of Interest (CoI) has become a cornerstone for collaboration, connecting researchers and stakeholders to advance our shared goals. The CoI has organized four online meetings, each one following a structured format that includes the presentation on the latest project updates, interactive sessions where members provide feedback on the INLINE forecast products, and training on specific products and functionalities.

Now counting over 80 practitioners from a network of 61 institutions across 21 countries, the CoI continues to strengthen connections and foster knowledge exchange across the project community.
